Abstract:	Bradford College was a four-year co-educational liberal arts college located in what was the town of Bradford, MA. The Bradford College collection encompasses from the founding of the College in 1803 until its closure in 2000 though Trustee minutes, various correspondence, newspaper clippings, and other assorted materials.

Organizational History

Bradford College was founded in 1802 and incorporated as a school in 1803. The school was founded as a way to provide better education for the sons and daughters of the well off resident of Bradford. These included the Chadwicks and the Kimball's. In 1803 shares were sold to raise money for the school. Thirty people invested in the school including Edward Kimball; Benjamin Walker; Moses Kimball John Peabody; Jonathan Chadwick and Nathaniel Thurston among others. Located in the village of Bradford, which would later be annexed to the city of Haverhill in 1897. From 1803 until 1836 the school was a coeducational school where the males would be taught during the summer and winter terms while the women would be taught during the summer terms. During the early years, the school would face financial troubles due to keeping the tuition low to allow more students to attend. The 1860s the school would turn around with Miss Abby Johnson as principal the school would thrive again.

The Trustees had decided in early 1836 to make Bradford Academy a woman's only school with Abigail Hasseltine serving as the principal with the goal of training women to be useful in the "home—children—the nursery and the fireside—the family circle." The school would continue to grow and expand adding buildings to accommodate the needs of the students. The school would suffer from short falls over the years, in the 1850s the school faced a \$50,000 short fall. One reason was a sharp drop in enrollment between 1855-1857. Another included the fact that the school was still paying a mortgage on some of the new buildings on campus, which helped to create a drain on the school along with Abigail Hasseltine a present of three-hundred dollars.

When Marion Coats came to the school in 1918 as principal. She was a graduate of Vassar College (1907) and completed a master's degree at Radcliffe College. The school started to serve the wider needs of the students with an equal divide between those attending Bradford Academy as a two-year preparatory school and other looking to Bradford as a junior college. Under Marian Coats leadership the process to become a Junior College began in 1925 though it would not be completed until 1932 when Dorothy M. Bell was the principal (1932-1967) and the school was renamed Bradford Junior College. The school would be accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges and received its accreditation in December of 1931. In 1971 the school became a college and again to admit men again to help keep enrollment numbers up at the school.

From 1982-1989 Arthur Levin was the president of the college. One of his longest lasting legacies of his tenure was creating the "Bradford Plan," which all the majors became constrictions and all students would choose one of five majors: Creative Arts, Humanities, Human Studies, Management and Natural Science and Mathematics. Within those majors, students can then have a concentration such as English, biology or create an interdisciplinary concentration. His vision was to have an "applied liberal-arts" program that would be interdisciplinary and allow students to change and succeed after graduation. The college would continue to increase enrollment and provide students with real world experience, which allow students to graduate from Bradford College ready to fill any job. Despite these gains the schools overall enrollment never increased past 500 students, which was needed to for the school to continue on and keep its endowment secure.

In November of 1999 the Trustees voted to close the college. The reason for the closing was because of competition for students; a modest endowment; issues with debt and not having a clear marketing approach for over a decade. The school had been running an annual deficit since 1989; though that debt was under \$1 million. In the mid-1990s the school administrators attempted to reform the curriculum, but ran into issues with the faculty. The college had as many

as forty majors with only thirty-five full time faculty. In May of 1997 a consultant recommended eliminating many of the areas of concentration and solely focus on the schools strengths. The building of additional dorms is the nail in the coffin; the Trustees voted in October of 1996 to build two new dormitories and would be paid for by the selling of bonds. The ability to repay those bonds were made on two assumptions: enrollment would reach 750 students by 2000 and the financial aid the school gave would decrease from 30.2 percent in 1997 to 28.8 in 1999. Over the next few years enrollment did not meet the anticipated expectations and with the need to attract student's financial aid that the school offered went up to almost fifty percent. By 1999 there were only 497 fulltime students lower than expected enrollment a tuition discount went to sixty percent and the annual operating deficit was \$5.2 million dollars.

On Tuesday, November 23, 1999 Jean Scott, Bradford College president, announced that the school would close at the end of the 1999-2000 school year. The college held several college fairs to help student's transfer and faculty made efforts to find other jobs since many job openings had closed around the time of the closing announcement. Several local colleges and universities looked at buying the campus, but none of the schools were interested. The school would sit abandoned for several years. In 2001 several of the properties that were not part of the main campus were sold to pay creditors. On December 31, 2001 the College voluntarily withdrew from accreditation. The Wreath School, which is a school for boys who have been abused or neglected, looked to purchase the campus in 2002. There was a public outcry and calls to block the sale. The City of Haverhill at one point looked to purchase the school as a way to block the Wreath School from purchasing Bradford campus because of fears the students would commit crimes and lower property values. The Wreath School is a school for students who have learning disabilities and emotional issues. These deals would fall through along with several others until 2007 when David Green the CEO of Hobby Lobby purchased the campus and donated the campus to Zion Bible College, which was located in Barrington, Rhode Island. In 2008 the campus reopened. In 2013 the college changed its name to Northpoint Bible College.

Scope and Content Note

Series one contains materials that relate to the founding of Bradford College and its general history. Included is the book that the founders used to create the school for the years 1803-1843. There are also historical events that relate to the school from 1812-1930. In addition, this Series contains materials that relate to the period when the school was a Junior College. Materials include the history of the bell at the school; the chapel; Sesquicentennial of Ann Hasseltine Judson work and stationary from the school.

Series two contains materials that relate to the founders of Bradford College and including the Principal of the Academy; President reports and correspondence; strategic planning; Trustees and Secretary of the Trustees. Included is the book that the founders used to create the school for the years 1803-1843. There are also historical events that relate to the school from 1812-2000. Series three contains annual reports from the Principal of Bradford Academy to the Trustees from 1919 to 1925. Also included is a report that was commissioned about the school transitioning to become a Junior College. In addition, is a report on the aims of the college and reports from the Joseph Short, College president along with newspaper clippings that relate to the Trustees and the Presidents of the College.

Series three contains spreadsheets that show the payroll for the faculty and staff of Bradford Junior College from the years 1956-1960. Also included is the treasurer's book that covers the debits, credits and money transfers and covers the years 1963-1973.

Series four contains materials that relate to the Library at Bradford Junior College. The Library printed a booklet or list each semester listing the books that were purchased for the collection. The booklets were titled Bradford Browsers; these booklets were mainly for the faculty.

Series five contains materials that relate to the running of the school and events that were for the benefit of the students along with publications that relate to the school and from former students.

Series six contains materials that relate to the recruitment and admission office. These include pamphlets; tuition fees and newsletters.

Series seven contains essays and class assignments that were written by students at Bradford. The majority of the essays are from the essay writing prizes that the faculty chose. The many of later essays are final projects that seniors wrote.

Series eight contains documents, agreements and newspaper clippings about the closing of the College in 2000. Included are the transfer agreements and container lists between Bradford College, Haverhill Public Library and the Haverhill Historical Society. Newspaper clippings cover from the first announcement of the College closing until the school opened up again in 2007 at Zion College.

Series nine contains articles and newspaper clippings. These clippings cover important events throughout Bradford history, which include grants that the school has been awarded; students volunteering; graduation exercises and graduations among other events.

Series ten contains booklets with images of Bradford Academy including the campus facilities and other areas of the Academy. Some of these are hardcover while others are softcover they showcase.

Series eleven contains two volumes of bound syllabi for the 1926-1927 school year. Volume one covers world literature while volume two covers the other courses, English, history, science among others.

Series twelve contains student directories and handbooks that contain school songs; faculty regulations; school organizations; and traditions among other things covered. The address book includes the names and home addresses of every student for that academic year.

Series thirteen contains materials school catalogues from when the school was an Academy to a College. The catalogues include admission of students; aims of the school; Trustees; academic calendar; course listings by department; graduation requirements and academic honesty among other topics, which evolved over the history of the school.

Series fourteen contains materials information about class reunions; correspondence from the Alumni Office; programs and general materials from the Alumni Office and class reunions.

Series fifteen contains materials programs; order of exercises; sermons; commencement invitations; newspaper clippings and articles that relate to commencement at the school.

Series sixteen contains materials that do not relate to any of the other materials in this collection. One folder contains songs that were song by the students that relate to the Academy, another is about the Bradford Woods and an essay about the woods. The last folder is unsorted materials that have no dates.

Series seventeen contains materials publications that relate to the alumni including the alumni newsletters, magazines, bulletins, and alumni directories.

Series eighteen contains materials that relate to student clubs, societies and organizations at the school. These materials mostly include the by-laws, treasurer's book and constitutions. Some of the books include notes and member lists for a given year.

Series nineteen contains student publications most notability is the Quill, which was the school newspaper from the time the school was an Academy to when I was a Junior College. I addition, this series has several issues the schools literary magazine *The Bradford Review* including the final issue.

Series twenty contains student autography books that were donated to the school. Each autograph book includes the signatures and notes of students from the school.

Series twenty-one contains materials programs and advertisements for student productions, playbills, recitals, and correspondence of the Masqueraders from the period when the school was an academy to when the school was an accredited College.

Series twenty-two contains playbills, recital programs and advertisements for outside groups and individuals who performed at the school.

Series twenty-three includes student notebooks that have been donated by former students to the school. These notebooks cover a variety of school topics from literature to the sciences.

Series twenty-four contains materials that relate to the art class when the school was a Junior College and includes color wheels and assignments. In addition, notes as a sponsor for the art club and Monday Evening Club.

Series twenty-five contains correspondence of Marion Coats who was one of the principals of Bradford Academy from 1918-1926. During her time as principal would mark the growth of the school. Her work at the school would also lead to the building of an infirmary, which would be named in her honor because when she became principal she had to deal with the influenza epidemic of 1918. In addition, she would help move the school from academy status to a junior college. She would leave to become the first President of Sarah Lawrence College for Women.

Series twenty-six contains notes made by Jean Pond who wrote and published a history of Bradford Academy in 1930. A portion of her notes are written on index cards.

Series twenty-seven contains the H-Z of the Bradford Archives card catalogue.

Series twenty-eight contains recordings of the a cappella group Tabooz. Tabooz was a self-directed group that formed in 1943 and performed at the annual freshman show. The group would continue to perform and record until the early 1970s.

Series twenty-nine contains yearbooks that from the time the school was an Academy; Junior College and a College. The yearbooks include in the class photos, clubs and athletics sports at the school.

Series thirty contains oversized photographs that were taken by the school and are mostly of students playing, student performances and sport activities.

Series thirty-one contains photos that relate to the class of 1876. These include, class, faculty, staff, Trustee and students which are not currently named. Also included are class identification photos. Also included are letters that relate to the provenance of the photos.

Series thirty-two contains photographs that are so large that they do not fit into standard photo containers. Many of these photos are unsorted and focus on life at the College such as martial arts demonstrations; construction of Humanities Study Center and aerial photos of the school among other events.

Series thirty-three contains proofs and negatives that relate to a booklet or pamphlet that the College produced in the 1990s. They include the inauguration of President Joseph Short; move in day and faculty and staff among other events.

Series thirty-four contains calendars that were produced for the students and for family by the College. Each calendar has a photograph of a building or event at Bradford Junior College for the years 1945-1978.

Series thirty-five contains photographs that are unsorted and cover a wide verity of events such as physical education; musical and play performances and former staff and faculty among other events. Many of these photographs were part of scrapbooks that were in poor condition

Series thirty-six contains class photo from the time the school was called Bradford Junior College. All of the students would sit in front of Academy Hall or near Tupelo Lake and have the a photo taken of the class. It appears that the photos were sold to either the students or to the parents because on some of the photos a price of \$0.75 appears on some of the photos.

Series thirty-seven contains scrapbooks that students of Bradford have created during their time at the school. Many of these scrapbooks cover events that were important to the students who made the scrapbook.

Series thirty-eight contains slides of events, places and people at Bradford Junior College and College. Stage productions, physical education classes and off campus excursions are included in the slides.

Series thirty-nine contains two copper plate negatives of Bradford and Bradford Academy.

Series forty has three objects are the official school seals that would have been used on the schools transcripts, diplomas and other official school documents. There is also the Margaret Davis & Margaret Ryan Reception Room Plaque.
